On a computer

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More .
3. Click History  History.

Clear your history

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More .
3. Click History  History.
4. On the left, click Clear browsing data. A box will appear.
5. From the drop-down menu, select how much history you want to delete. To clear everything, select All time.
6. Check the boxes for the info you want Chrome to clear, including "browsing history." [Learn more about the types of browsing data you can delete](#)
7. Click Clear data.

iPhone and iPad

1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the Chrome app .
2. At the bottom right, tap More   History .

Clear your history

1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the Chrome app .
2. At the bottom right, tap More   History .
3. At the bottom, tap Clear Browsing Data.
4. Check Browsing history. It may be checked by default.
5. Uncheck any other items you don't want to delete.
6. Tap Clear Browsing Data  Clear Browsing Data.
7. At the top right, tap Done.

Android

On your Android phone or tablet, open the Chrome app .

1. At the top right, tap More   History.
 - If your address bar is at the bottom, swipe up on the address bar. Tap History .
2. To visit a site, tap the entry.
 - To open the site in a new tab, touch and hold the entry. At the top right, tap More   Open in new tab.
 - **To copy the site, touch and hold the entry. At the top right, tap More   Copy link.**

Clear your history

1. On your Android phone or tablet, open the Chrome app .
2. At the top right, tap More   History.
 - If your address bar is at the bottom, swipe up on the address bar. Tap History .
3. Tap Clear browsing data.
4. Next to "Time range," select how much history you want to delete. To clear everything, tap All time.
5. Check "Browsing history." Uncheck any other data you don't want to delete.
6. Tap Clear data.
